2018 TRAIL CLOSURES AND DETOURS

(information provided by municipalities)

Dear Bike to Work Day commuters,

As Bike to Work Day approaches, note various trail closures and detours throughout the metro area. Although this information has been provided by local municipalities, it should not be considered all-inclusive. Please contact your local city or county public works department for more information. This document will be updated if further information becomes available.

CITIES

Aurora

The West Fork of Second Creek Trail is closed in High Point, north of 64th due to Aurora Water Construction. The work area is a few hundred feet east of Dunkirk and is expected to last through the summer.

The Sand Creek Regional Greenway Trail between Colfax to Airport road has a potential for impact from surrounding construction equipment and workers on the trail. Although this trail is not closed, riders should be advised.

Commerce City

The Fernald Trail is closed due to the construction of the Regional Transportation District's North Metro Rail Line.

The South Platte River Trail can be accessed via the Sand Creek Trail (the trails meet around E. 64th Ave. and I-270, but there is not a trailhead where they meet.)

There are trailheads with parking at E. 64th Ave. and York St., E. 74th Ave. just west of the river, and E. 88th Ave. and Colorado Blvd.

Cherry Creek Trail

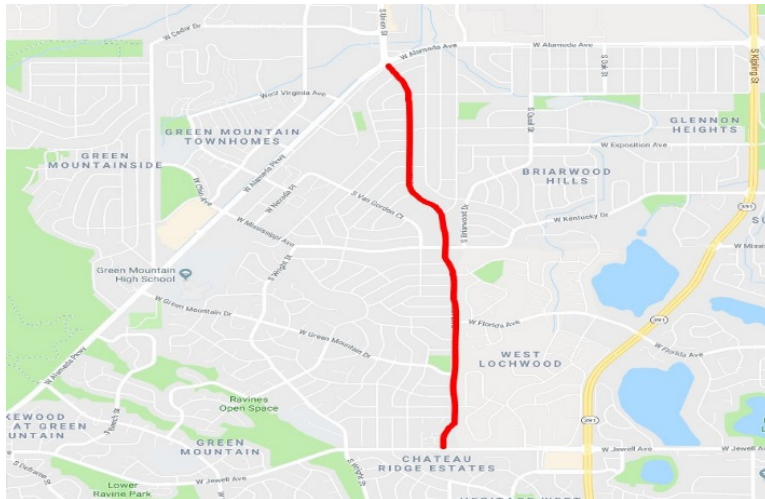
- Plaza: between Broadway, Lincoln, 6th and 7th Avenues
- Quebec to Iliff: Metro Wastewater project: Trail users will be detoured to Cherry Creek Drive ([VIEW MAP](#)).
- University Blvd. & City of Karmiel Park (South side): Cherry Creek Trail runs along both the north and south sides of the creek—the SOUTH side of this portion of trail is currently closed for necessary maintenance and repairs. The north side remains open as an alternate route.

South Platte River Trail

- Globeville Landing Park: Local detour at Globeville Landing Park. The detour directs users to cross at the light at Arkins and 38th vs. utilizing the underpass at 38th ([VIEW MAP](#)).

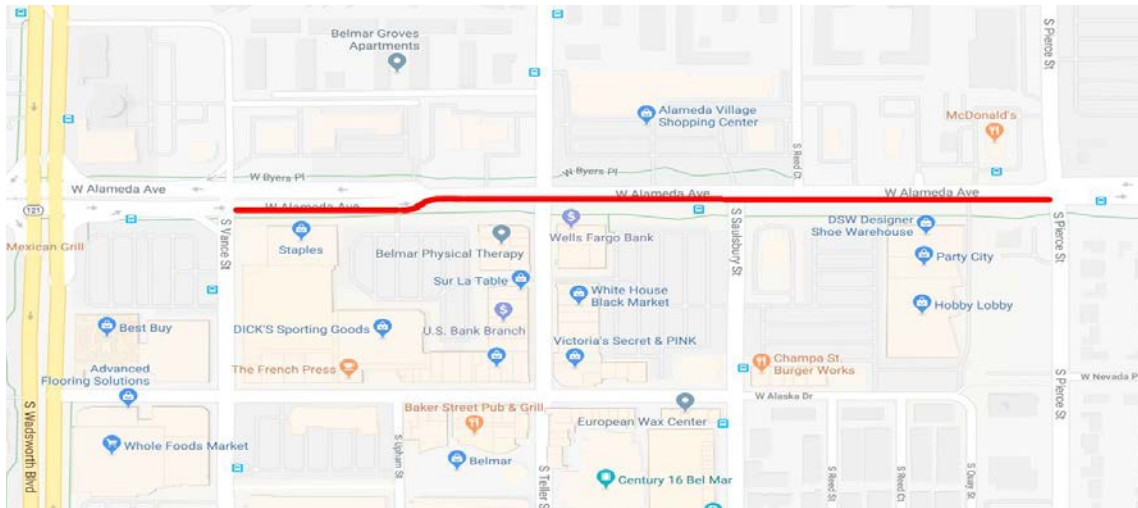
Lakewood

Union Blvd from Alameda to Jewell will be under construction for an overlay project and bicyclists will need to avoid that route.



Lakewood (cont.)

The south side of Alameda will be closed from Vance Street to Pierce Street. North-side facilities will not be impacted. Bicyclists have safe crossings to the north side of Alameda at both intersections.



Littleton

Northbound and southbound Mary Carter Trail will be closed to demo the old eastbound South Platte River Bridge. Beginning June 18 for approximately two weeks. Trail closed 24/7.

Westminster

Little Dry Creek - closed from Irving Street (at Westminster Station Park) to 64th for PWU's sewer interceptor project ([VIEW MAP](#)).

Big Dry Creek at 120th Avenue – The trail on the south side of 120th will be closed from the Big Dry Creek trail (just west of Federal Blvd) west to Lowell Blvd.
